## SCBA TRAILER USE

---

### **LOGISTICAL CONSIDERATIONS**

1. The requesting agency must be a participating member of the Boone County Fire Chief's Association or an agency which maintains a training mutual aid relationship with the Boone County Fire Chief's Association.
2. The requesting agency is responsible for transporting the unit from storage to their training site and returning the unit back to the storage site. The storage site currently is the Point Pleasant Fire Protection District, 3444 Turfway Road, Erlanger, KY.
3. The unit is a 53' standard trucking trailer and does not have a designated road tractor to haul the unit. The requesting agency is responsible for securing a tractor to transport the trailer. Any UASI tractor can tow the unit.
4. The unit ***is not*** an exempt vehicle. The driver/operator must have a Class "A" Commercial Driver's License in order to haul the unit on any roadway.
5. Insurance is maintained by the Boone County Fire Chief's Association, but the requesting agency is responsible for any damage incurred to the unit while they maintain possession of the unit.
6. The pad-lock code is 0451.
7. Driver operators should park the unit on as flat a surface as possible when placing the unit.
8. The doors cannot be closed and locked with the stairwells in place. The stairwells must be removed prior to locking and securing the unit between training sessions.

### **OPERATIONAL CONSIDERATIONS**

1. The requesting agency and instructor-in-charge assume all responsibility for student injury, damage to the unit, and damage to equipment (including personal PPE) when they have possession of the unit and are conducting classes.

2. If the unit is parked on an un-even surface, the trailer will flex and some of the panels may be difficult to remove and/or install.
3. The unit does **not** have a ventilation system within it. Instructors should exercise due caution and monitor the interior temperature of the unit to avoid temperature extremes and ensure the safety of all participants.
4. The unit does not have a lighting system in the interior. Instructors should make appropriate arrangements to ensure the safety of all participants.
5. Participants should always utilize the door hold-open devices or make appropriate arrangements to secure the doors to prevent injury or damage from swinging doors; particularly during high wind days.
6. Commercial smoke generators can be used inside the unit. There is a hose and port in the front storage area of the unit for this purpose. ***The use of smudge pots, flares, or any open flame within the unit is strictly forbidden!***
